## The top 5 online exhibitions in physical spaces

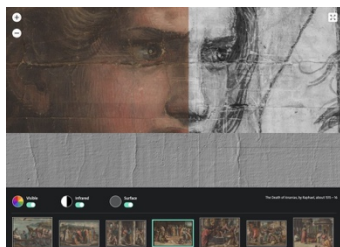

Beautiful modern designs paired up with striking artworks including Yinka Shonibare's colourful figures. How could this pairing of Modernity and Stephen Friedman Gallery be better? By sticking it all within a stunning Georgian mansion, that's how. It's all been installed and I can't wait to visit once it's safe to do so. For now we can ascend through four curated floors and experience it all virtually. Until 2 April.

One of the most impressive items in the V&A collection are these seven magnificent large scale tapestry designs.



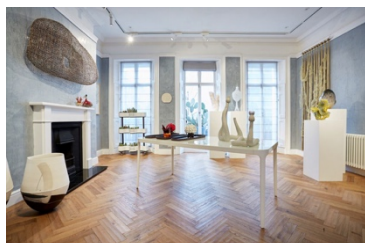
Until we can see them in person the museum website recounts their story online and how it links to pivotal moments in European history. Plus there's an interactive tool that allows us to slide across each and see the underdrawings under infrared light.

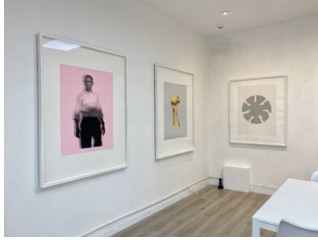
