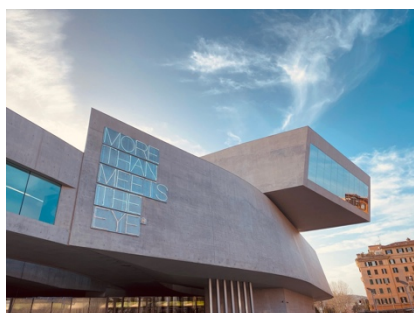

The MAXXI - National Museum of XXI Century Arts reopens its doors with an exceptional programme of exhibitions, focuses and special projects, accompanied by a rich public programme and many educational activities for children, students and families, online and in presence.

An Italian genius of world architecture: Aldo Rossi. A great artist who is still a source of inspiration for many creative people today: Giacomo Balla. An absolute master of photography: Sebastião Salgado. Two crucial protagonists of the international art scene: Thomas Hirschhorn and Cao Fei. A reflection on the themes of our time in the A Story for the Future. MAXXI's first decade's project, the engaging exhibition/installation conceived for the Museum's tenth anniversary and in the group show dedicated to the contemporary art scene in the countries of former Yugoslavia.
